

Insy™ Television & Messaging

User's Guide

Application overview

If you ever wondered if it is possible to send live video messages from one mobile phone to another for free, then you have already understood what Insy™ is all about. All you need is a wireless Internet connection and a compatible device (any of the latest S60 3rdEdition devices are supported).

And that is not all that Insy™ can do. Broadcasting worldwide is the other great feature we included in the the 1.0 release. It would be fun and entertaining to watch what other members of the community have decided to share with us. And you can always post live or pre-uploaded video clips.

Version 2.0 brings the “news broadcasting” feature. This allows you to share important news with all your followers. Sending always interesting and veridical news, will ensure you a great number of loyal followers. But on the other hand you should not get lured by quick popularity and forward every spectacular piece of information you can find, you should always check your news, otherwise your credibility will fall.

We are constantly working to include new high quality professional television productions on Insy™ platform. Your preferred TV channels, sport shows and essential economic and social news, all would be available in the *TVBox*.

Insy™ NLSTV is an implementation of a nonlinear signaled television system. It has the following characteristics:

- receive television shows
- broadcast and receive user generated content
- send and receive personal content (video messaging)
- modify content meta-data (title, description)
- receive advertising content
- invite participants and manage contact list

Quick startup guide

Step1: Creating a new account

When the application is started for the first time you are asked to create a new user account. The information provided should be accurate and complete. All fields, except *Device name* are mandatory. If the device name is missing a default value will be used.

As soon as the account is created you will receive a notification e-mail, including your password and login name. Please note that **the password is case sensitive**, once you enter a wrong password is recommended to exit the application and restart it before you try again.



Note: The application requires a full Internet access point. WAP access points are not supported. When using 3G it is recommended to have an unlimited traffic data plan, or at least 100MB included traffic.

Step 2: Adding contact list members

The next step is to add members on your contact list. For this you must open the *Contacts* view available in the main screen and select *New contact* from the *Options* menu.

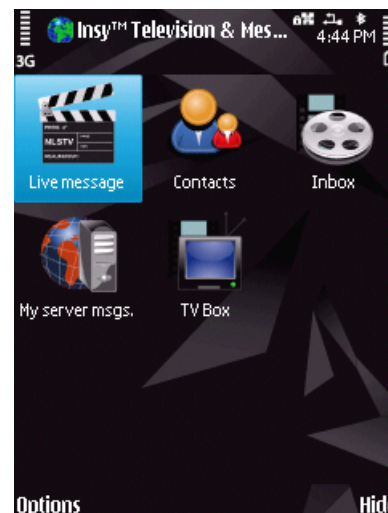
When the person you are adding already has an Insy TV user account, then only the e-mail address associated with his/hers account is needed. Otherwise a new preliminary limited account will be created for him/her and an invitation e-mail will be sent on your behalf.

Step 3: Sending live messages

Either opening the *Live message* view from the main screen or selecting the *New live message* from the *Options* menu will bring you to the message details view. Here you can choose a title and a description for your video message.

This step can be skipped and you can go directly to the next view and select the message destination. Later on you will have the possibility to edit message details directly on the server.

If no message destination is selected during this step the video clip shall be only uploaded to the server, without being sent to any user. At a later time you can edit its details and forward it to any destination. In fact this is the recommended procedure to follow when sending any public message (<Worldwide> message).



Go live option will initiate message uploading on the server, once the first few bits arrive on the server the message recipients are notified and they are able to initiate live streaming of that message.



Tip: You can easily navigate between live message views using navigation left/right buttons.



Tip: In the preview view, before pressing *Go live*, you can use navigation up/down buttons to change camera. On touch screen devices this is done by tapping the screen.

Step 4 (optional): Edit and forward messages

My server msgs. is the place where you can manage your own messages. Available operations are message details editing (message title and message description), message forwarding and message deletion.



Note: In order to be able to receive notifications about new messages the application must be running and connected to the Internet.

To help you save battery life the *Settings* menu allows you to set the time interval when the application should be connected. The default activity interval is 8:00 AM to 10:00 PM. Also in the *Settings* you can choose to start the application automatically when the phone is powered on.

Invited to Insy™

When someone you know has sent you a formal invitation to Insy™ a preliminary account will be automatically created for you. This type of account is only half functional, meaning you are able to receive messages to it, but nobody can see them or send any message from the account until you complete account creation. To do that you have to select *Create new* option when the application is started for the first time and to use same *E-mail* and *Password* data you have received in your invitation.

Public messages on Insy™

There are two types of public messages: worldwide public messages and news messages. The difference is that worldwide messages are sent to everybody and usually the receiver is not notified on incoming messages.

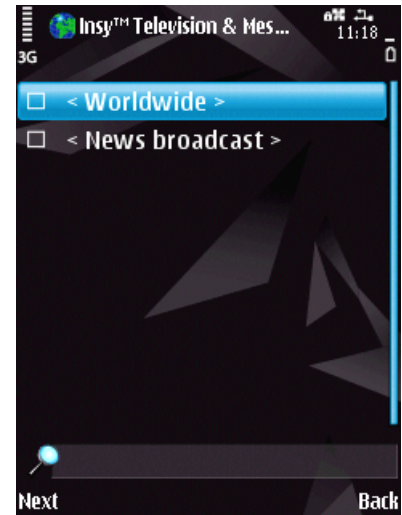
On the other hand the news are more direct. They are sent only to the sender's *followers* and

the receiver of the news is instantly notified. On his turn, the receiver of a news message can forward it further to his own followers.

You can become a *follower* either by selecting a certain message and choosing the *Receive news* options menu. Or, in the Inbox *News* folder, by adding a news source and entering the nickname of a person you know.



Tip: At any time you can block receiving news from any source by selecting *Block news* from the Options menu.



Sometimes the same news are forwarded by more sources, you will block only one of it at a time and only your direct sender, not the original source.

Television channels

Television channels are better seen in full screen and landscape mode. Consequently the playback automatically starts in full screen. To switch back to normal view, you need to press central navigation button or, on touch screen devices, to tap the screen.

Not all television channels are available for all the regions. There are restrictions, imposed by content distribution agreements, for the area where a TV channel can be viewed. At the time when this documentation was written, the only widely available channel was Deutsche Welle Europe.



Tip: In order to be able to select available television channels, make sure the correct country is selected in your account profile. (main screen Options>Advanced>Change account details)
